# **"VOJVODINA OPEN 2023"**

Novi Sad, June 29 - July 5, 2023

# TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

## 1. Organizer, date and place of the event

The Chess Federation of Vojvodina, under the patronage of the Provincial Secretariat for Sports and Youth, is organizing an international open chess tournament called "VOJVODINA OPEN 2023" from 29th June to 5th of July 2023.

The tournament will be held in the **Ceremonial Hall of the Technical School "Mileva Marić Einstein"** (street Gagarinova no. 1).

## 2. The right to participate

All chess players have the right to participate in the tournament, regardless of title and rating. The tournament is played in two groups: "A" group for players with a minimum standard rating of 2100 and "B" group for players with a maximum standard rating of 2200.

Players with a rating between 2100 and 2200 can choose which group to play in.

The valid rating is the one on the day of application, which is the day of payment of the registration fee. The registered participant who pays the registration fee will not bear the consequences of the rating change until the start of the tournament.

The organizer reserves the right to allow the participation of a certain number of players who do not meet the prescribed conditions in the "A" group.

## 3. Competition system, the rate of play, norms and rating

In both groups, the tournament is played according to the Swiss system in 9 rounds.

In the "A" group, the tempo of the game is 90 minutes per player for 40 moves and 15 minutes until the end of the game, with an addition of 30 seconds for each move played, starting from the first, while in the "B" group the tempo of the game is 90 minutes per player for the entire game, with an addition of 30 seconds for each move played, starting with the first one.

In both groups, in the first six rounds, with prior announcement, the player can choose one round in which he will be unpaired, with half points awarded.

In the "A" group, it will be possible to win all international titles' norms. Both tournaments will be rated by FIDE.

#### 5. Prizes

The organizer has foreseen a prize fund in the total amount of 8,350€, divided into 28 prizes that will be distributed to participants (participants are not obliged to pay taxes).

The player can win only one prize and the highest in terms of money. Suppose the player acquires the right to two equal cash prizes. In that case, he/she will win the one listed according to the order in the Tournament regulations.

In case places are shared, prizes for participants that won 7 or more points in the "A" group will be divided according to the "Hort" principle. In contrast, other prizes will be divided according to additional criteria defined in the Tournament Rules.

#### 7. Accommodation

All participants are required to book accommodation through the organizer. Participants who insist on providing accommodation on their own (without the help of the organizer) pay a €25 higher registration fee.

The organizer has provided <u>special conditions</u> for players with a rating of over 2550 rating points. The number of these places is limited!

#### 8. Transfer

Participants and companions have at their disposal a transfer from Belgrade Airport to the hotel. The vehicle's price (1-3 people) is  $50 \in$  in one direction or  $90 \in$  for both directions. The transfer price for multiple passengers is available upon request.

### 9. Payment security and anti-cheating measures

Anti-cheating measures will be fully and thoroughly implemented at the tournament, in accordance with the FIDE rules. All measures will be elaborated in more detail in the rules of the competition. In case of cancellation, the money paid for the hotel will be returned with the attached documentation as proof of the reason for the cancellation, while the money paid for the registration fee is non-refundable.
